Support the expansion and timely implementation of safe and affordable drinking water programs, particularly for disadvantaged communities.

IMMIGRATION / NEW AMERICANS:

Promote Federal comprehensive immigration reform legislation that provides a pathway to citizenship for undocumented residents.
